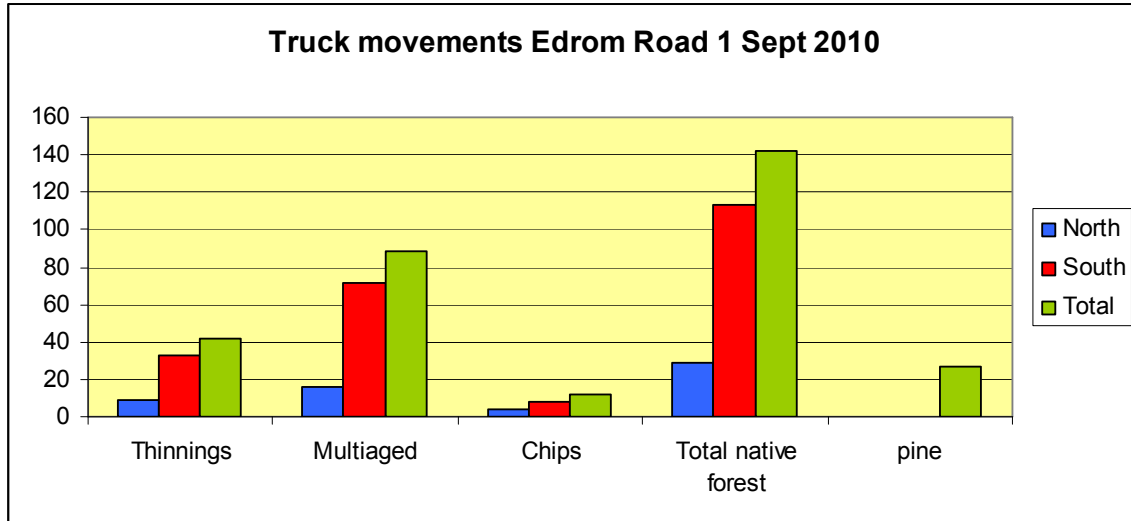
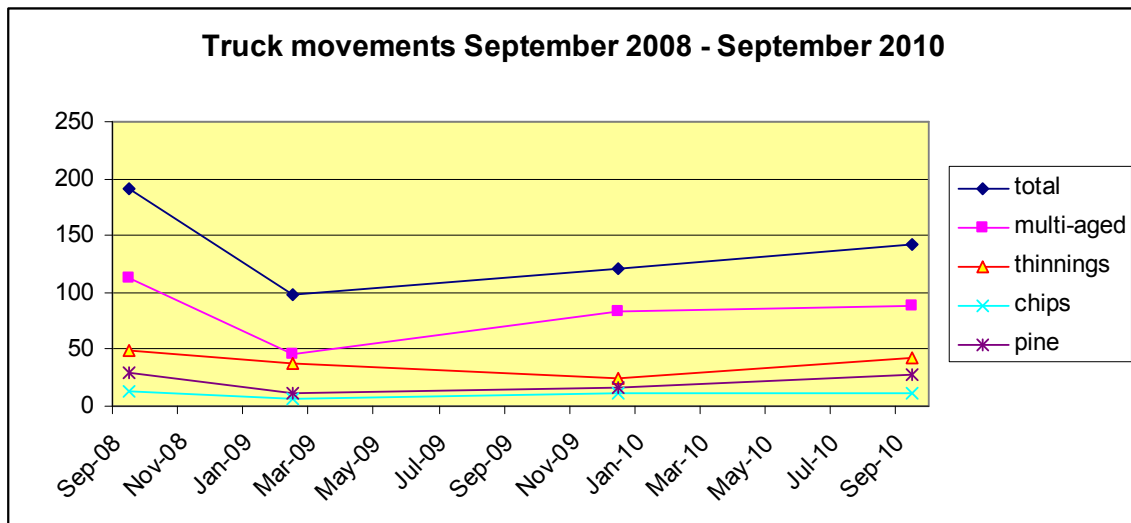


### Truck count, Edrom road corner 1 September 2010

At our previous count, in the depths of the Global Financial Crisis on 9 December 2009, the total of trucks was 121. This result is 17% up, but still 25% down on typical activity levels during 2008 and 2007.



The above chart shows how relatively low the sawmill chips and thinnings continue to be as a proportion of the chipmill's input. Multi aged forest continues to supply the bulk of the wood. The truck count of 1<sup>st</sup> September directly contradicts statements by the SEFE General Manager, Mr Peter Mitchell, who has repeatedly stated in mid 2010 that the chipmill was now running at full capacity and had orders to take whatever it could produce.
